Dear Master LIVE Applicants,

We apologize for the delay in the publication of the admission table. On March 16, the three countries and all universities managing the LIVE program were locked down and we were asked to work remotely with new installation and procedures. The interviews were all run as expected from March 10 to 12, 2020 and the final Jury of selection was held on March 12, 2020 to establish the list of selected students, published on March 26, 2020. Due to the ongoing covid-19 crisis, not only we but also you (the selected applicants after interviews) have problems to timely provide the requested administrative documents. Among the requested proof of residence, 10 are still awaited, including one in the 25 admitted students. We have nevertheless decided to publish the admission table while delaying the deadline to provide this legal proof of residence (initial deadline: by Jan 23, 2020).

Therefore, please **provide your legal proof of residence (see Annex II and "Res" written in red in the table) by April 19, 2020**. Then, we will withdraw students with no legal proof of residence from the table of the selected students.

**ALL STEPS (1-2-3-4) completed: ADMINISTRATIVE ELIGIBILITY - REVIEW, PRESELECTION FOR INTERVIEW - INTERVIEW FOR FINAL SELECTION - SCHOLARSHIP AWARDING.**

We will welcome and train 25 students in the Master LIVE 2020-2022. We have applied the EACEA rules to award the scholarships. The awarding of scholarships will be formally approved by EACEA, the Education, Audiovisual and Culture Executive Agency of the European Commission (also now working remotely) in April 2020 and we will keep you informed. According to their merit in the selection process, 21 students will receive a full scholarship from EACEA to take in charge their participation costs (registration fees), travel and subsistence during their 2-year training, as described in the personalized letter of admission, which will be sent separately to the admitted students, in April 2020. Please read the details on EACEA scholarships provided in Annex I.

The characteristics of the scholarships that we have obtained for the Master LIVE 2020 are as follow:

- 13 full scholarships funded by EACEA for students with Partner (non-European) country nationalities (EACEA-PARTc).
- 5 full scholarships funded by EACEA for students with targeted country nationalities (EACEA-TARGc).
- 3 full scholarships funded by EACEA for students with Programme country nationalities (EACEA-ProgC): ProgC include European and a few other countries funding the EMJMD programme.
- 1 full scholarship funded by Institut Mérieux, for students with European economic area (EEA) country nationalities (AP-progC Institut Mérieux).
- 3 self-funded seats are available for the LIVE 2020. Another partial scholarship funded by Sanofi Pasteur should be award to lower the cost of one self-funded seat.

For admission, the selected candidates are considered according to their merit in the selection process and scholarship awarding respects several rules requested by our funding partners, such as: gender equity ( $0.7 < M/F < 1.5$ ), at least 75% of non-European

nationalities, a maximum of three students with the same nationality and different study profiles (DVM, MD, PharmD, Scientist/Engineer). For the self-funded seats, we only call the candidates who declared to have the possibility to be self-funded. In case of withdrawal of an admitted student, we must respect these rules to call the next suitable applicant from the pending list. For this purpose, we have a reserve list of applicants.

- "Reserve": the applicants have already been interviewed and selected.

- "Reserve for interview": the applicants will be contacted to organize interviews if withdrawals open new avenue for their selection.

About the 2020 LIVE selection process: 905 applicants (M/F = 1.22) have registered on MyLIVE, the online application system to apply for the Master LIVE. 122 students were recommended for interview. From the 72 interviews (M/F = 0.95), 51 applicants (M/F = 1.04) were selected and 25 students (M/F = 1.27) are now called for admission. The level of the interviewed applicants was excellent. Due to the limited number of seats, we can only welcome the applicants with the best rank, among many bright applicants. We thank all the remarkable applicants who have participated: the 2020 LIVE selection rate is 2.8%.

## ANNEX I EMJMD Student Scholarships

(from the reference "Erasmus+: KA1 Higher Education Erasmus Mundus Joint Master Degrees – Erasmus+ Programme Guide – Version 2 (2018): 15/12/2017 – page 102.)

The EMJMD student scholarships include:

- a contribution to the student participation costs (including the tuition fees, library and laboratory costs, full insurance coverage and any other mandatory costs related to the student participation in the Master);
- a contribution to student travel and installation costs;
- a monthly subsistence allowance for the entire duration of the EMJMD study programme.

Details on the EMJMD student scholarship amounts are given in the table below:

Contribution to subsistence costs will not be given to the scholarship holders for the EMJMD periods (study/research/placement/thesis preparation) spent in their country of residence, nor to scholarship holders from a Partner Country for the EMJMD periods exceeding one trimester (i.e. 3 months or the equivalent of 15 ECTS credits) spent in any Partner Country.</p>

<sup>82</sup> Students who are not residents nor have carried out their main activity (studies, training or work) for more than a total of 12 months over the last five years in a Programme Country. The five-year reference period for this 12-month rule is calculated backwards as from the submission deadline defined by the consortia of applying for an EMJMD student scholarship.



## ANNEX II LEGAL PROOF OF RESIDENCE

**Q: I wanted to be sure before submitting my application if my Certificate of residence is fine. What are the criteria?**

A: A "Proof of Residence" is an official document such as a residence certificate issued in accordance with your municipality normal registration rules, a bill for your place (electricity, phone, water...), a certificate of your place of work, study or training issued by the related employer or higher education institution or another document that fulfils the criteria mentioned below.

The "Proof of Residence" must show:

- your name and surname as written on your passport
- your address, including the city (as when you send a letter to this address)
- a date not older than one year before the MyLIVE deadline

If the original document is not in English, you must also provide a translated copy with the original.

If you have a proof of residence (bill of electricity, of phone or...) with the name of a family member and not with your name, you must send:

- The copy of the proof of residence
- a sworn letter of the same family member with her/his copy of ID.

Please find below an English model for the sworn letter (example if it is father's home):
